

SERIES: "PURPOSE BUILDERS"

WEEK 1: "MOSES THE DELIVERER"

VERSE TO MEMORIZE:

"The Lord will work out his plans for my life". (Psalms 138:8 NLT)

INTERACTIVE QUESTIONS:

- How does Moses inspire you?
- What excuses have you given to God in order to not do certain things?
- What are your fears of doing something new or different?
- How do you think God wants to use you in your workplace and where you study?
- Would you like to find your purpose?

PRACTICAL APPLICATION TO DISCOVER YOUR PURPOSE:

1. **Ask God why you were born.** In *Exodus 33:13* NLT Moses said to God: *"Let me know your ways"* because He is the creator of our purpose, the author of our lives.
2. **Ask God for His support.** To do what He has asked you to do on this Earth. Ask Him for his grace.
3. **Activate. (Exodus 14:15)** Move forward!
 - Don't miss church on Sunday.
 - Start reading the Bible everyday.
 - You could start reading the book "Change your world".
 - Start having time with God every morning before you go to work.

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WEEK 2:

JOSEPH: "THE REJECTED WITH PURPOSE"

VERSE TO MEMORIZE:

*"You intended to harm me, but God intended it all for good. **He brought me to this position so I could save the lives of many people**". (Genesis 50:20 NLT)*

INTERACTIVE QUESTIONS:

- What pit have you gotten yourself into?
- Have you let rejection or injustice stop your dreams?
- Are you a dreamer or have you stopped dreaming?
- What dreams has God given you?
- In what way does Joseph inspire you?

PRACTICAL APPLICATION TO CONTINUE IN PURSUANCE OF YOUR DREAMS:

- Write down the dreams that God has given you. What dreams did you have as a child?
- Write the names of the people who have rejected you and forgive them, pray for them and repeat everyday: "I forgive _____, I bless him/her and I release him/her".
- Begin to take action steps that lead you to the fulfillment of God's dreams for your life.

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WEEK 3:

NOAH: "THE FATHER WITH A PURPOSE"

VERSE TO MEMORIZE:

"So Noah did everything exactly as God had commanded him". (Genesis 6:22 NLT)

INTERACTIVE QUESTIONS:

- In what way did Noah inspire you?
- What person fulfilled their purpose and is the reason you are here today?
- In what way do you think your family will benefit from your decision to be here and learn more about God?
- What instructions has God given you that you have not yet done?

PRACTICAL APPLICATION TO DISCOVER YOUR PURPOSE:

- Write down what God has put in your heart to do. Example: Study Spanish, read the Bible, pray, study a career, prepare to be a leader, open your CG, etc. .
- Write down the action steps that will lead you to fulfill them, and write down the things you have to eliminate from your agenda that are unnecessary and that keep you from your purpose.
- Pray over that list, asking God to help you fulfill it. .

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WEEK 4:

NEHEMIAH: "THE PURPOSE BUILDER"

VERSE TO MEMORIZE:

*"So I answered them, and said to them, "The God of heaven Himself will prosper us; therefore we His servants will arise and **build**"... (Nehemiah 2:20 NKJV)*

INTERACTIVE QUESTIONS:

- How does Nehemiah inspire you?
- What do you have to rebuild?
- Have you lost hope of restoring your family?
- Had you stopped believing that you could be successful?
- What things have you stopped doing?

PRACTICAL APPLICATION IN ORDER TO BE BUILDER:

- Write down the things that are destroyed in your life that you need to start building. For example: in your spiritual, family, financial life, etc.
- Begin to build your spiritual life, taking time each day to pray, read the Bible and write what God speaks to you.
- Start edifying your words, giving affirmation, quality time, asking for forgiveness if necessary, from your spouse, children, or parents.
- It begins by building purposes in others, inviting someone to the CG and to church.

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WEEK 5:

ESTHER: "FROM ORPHAN TO QUEEN"

VERSE TO MEMORIZE:

"Who knows if perhaps you were made queen for just such a time as this!" (Esther 4:14 NLT)

INTERACTIVE QUESTIONS:

- How did Esther inspire you?
- Where has God placed you?
- What are your gifts or abilities?
- Do you know people who are suffering injustices?
- What can you do about it?

PRACTICAL APPLICATION TO DISCOVER YOUR PURPOSE:

- Share with the person next you right away and tell them what abilities or gifts you see in them.
- Start using your gifts by serving in your church and in your community..
- Start being a voice in your workplace, at school, and at home by sharing God's truths with others.
- Say a prayer declaring that this year is not going to be wasted, but that we are going to work together to be Purpose Builders.

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WEEK 6:

JESUS: "THE AUTHOR OF YOUR PURPOSE"

VERSE TO MEMORIZE:

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he has sent me to heal the brokenhearted; to proclaim liberty to the captives, and recovery of sight to the blind; to set a liberty those who are oppressed"... (Luke 4:18 NKJV)

INTERACTIVE QUESTIONS:

- How did our Lord Jesus inspire you?
- What did or has God done in your life?
- Do you know someone who needs emotional or physical healing?
- In what area have you stopped dreaming or having vision?

PRACTICAL APPLICATION TO DISCOVER YOUR PURPOSE:

- I invite you to continue in the church and in the CG. And if this CG is not going to continue, you can open one or someone from this group could open one so that you can all continue learning and growing. If not, talk to the leader to find you another CG near your house..
- **Receive Jesus in your heart.** You can't discover your purpose if you don't know who built your purpose. Accept Him in your heart! (Make the salvation prayer)
- Ask Jesus what your purpose is and why He created you.
- Trust Jesus in your purpose, your destiny, and your life.
- If you have not gone to a 3 DOP Retreat, we invite you to attend, because God wants to heal you, free you, fill you with His Holy Spirit and make your purpose known.
- Share in this CG what you learned during these six weeks of the "Purpose Builders" Series.
